

**Nomination/Recommendation for
The Class of 1944 Scholarship
for Bachelor of General Studies Students**

The Class of 1944 Scholarship for Bachelor of General Studies Students is a \$500 award made to outstanding Bachelor of General Studies students who meet the following criteria:

1. Evidence of a significant interruption in the candidate's formal education.

2. Academic achievement as an adult learner.

Applicants/nominees must have completed 15 UConn credits in the BGS Program and have a divisional grade point average of 3.0 or better. They must be currently registered for credit courses at UConn.

3. Potential for professional and personal achievement.

The application process includes submission of an essay of no more than 250 words by the applicant and **two** recommendations from UConn faculty or professional staff members other than BGS counselors. If the student is nominated by a faculty or staff member, one additional recommendation is required.

4. Financial circumstances.

Financial need will be considered as a criterion, although it is not the determining factor in the selection process.
