The Class of 1945 Scholarship for Bachelor of General Studies Students consists of two \$500 awards made to outstanding Bachelor of General Studies students who meet the following criteria:

**1. Evidence of a significant interruption in the candidate's formal education.**

**2. Academic achievement as an adult learner.**

Applicants/nominees must have completed 15 UConn credits in the BGS Program and have a divisional grade point average of 3.0 or better. They must be currently registered for credit courses at UConn.

**3. Potential for professional and personal achievement.**

The application process includes submission of an essay of no more than 250 words by the applicant and **two** recommendations from UConn faculty or professional staff members other than BGS counselors. If the student is nominated by a faculty or staff member, one additional recommendation is required.

**4. Financial circumstances.**

Financial need will be considered as a criterion, although it is not the determining factor in the selection process.
