

**Nomination/Recommendation for
The Morrison Scholarship
for Bachelor of General Studies Students**

The University of Connecticut's Center for Continuing Studies is currently accepting applications for three \$725 scholarships created exclusively for BGS students.

The Morrison Scholarship is based on four criteria:

1. **Enrollment as a student in the Bachelor of General Studies program; preference is given to female students enrolled at the Stamford campus.**
2. **Satisfactory academic status.**
3. **Pursuit of career advancement opportunities which will be facilitated by the completion of the Bachelor of General Studies program.**
4. **Demonstrated motivation, determination, persistence, and focus.**

The application process includes the submission of an essay of no more than 250 words by the applicant and **two** recommendations from UConn faculty or professional staff members other than BGS counselors. If a student is nominated by a faculty or staff member, one additional recommendation is required.

Financial need will be considered but is not the determining factor in the selection process.
